Published data covers all MHSDS activity and is not spit by CYP / adults

Comparison with other datasets

Ethnicity completion rates – May 2020

A&E	93%
APC (inpatients)	96%
CSDS (community)	70%
IAPT	95%
MHSDS	90%
MSDS (maternity)	94%
OP	94%

- The level of useful data is lower than reported in the overall DQMI as this includes '*not stated*'.

Ethnicity VODIM

- Recorded in MHSDS table MHS001 Master Patient Index
- Possible table entries are included in the *MHSDS Technical Output Specification*
- To interpret the VODIM report (and the monthly performance reports), refer to the *MHSDS monthly metadata file*

Default = 99 (Not known)

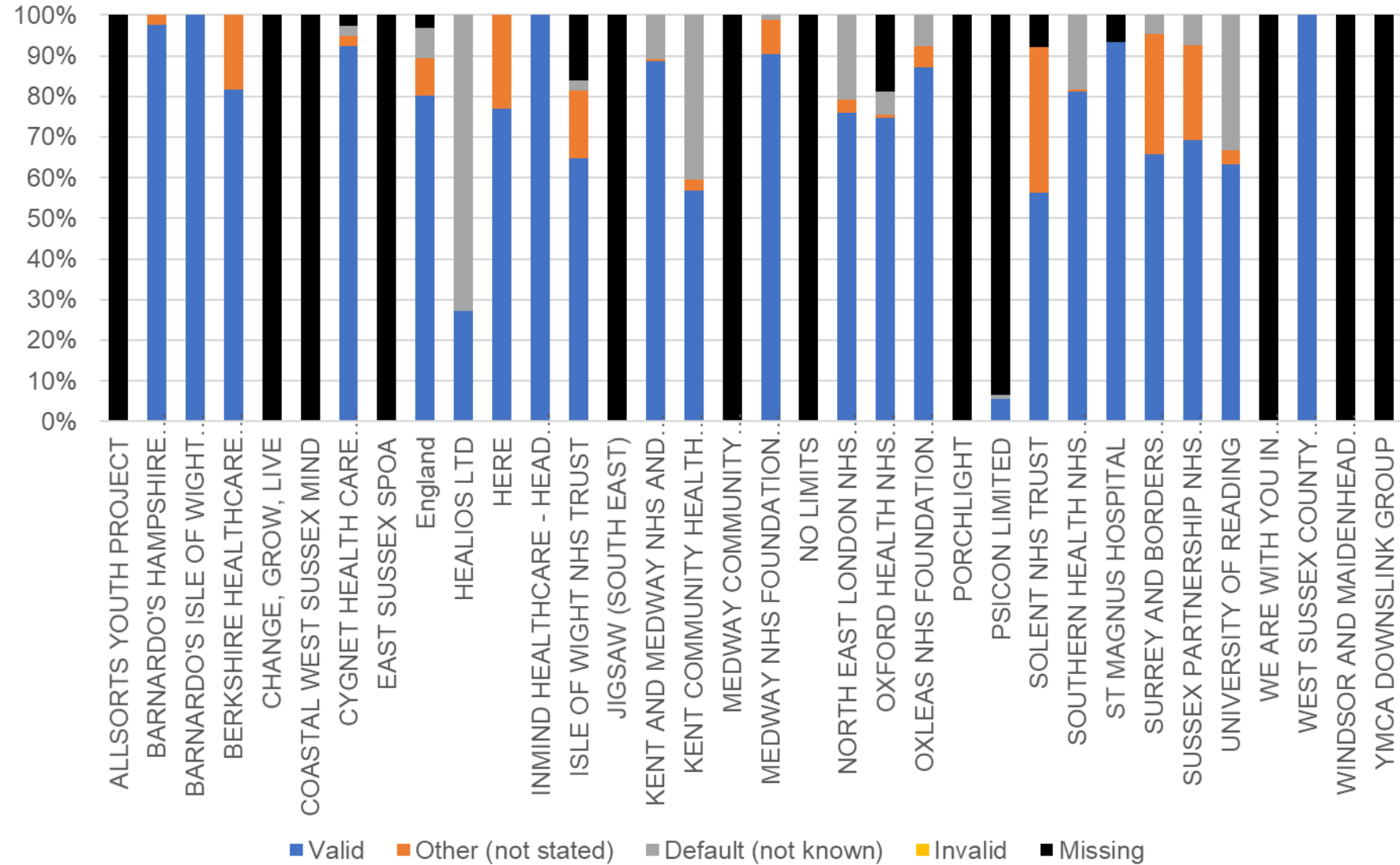
Invalid = anything else
